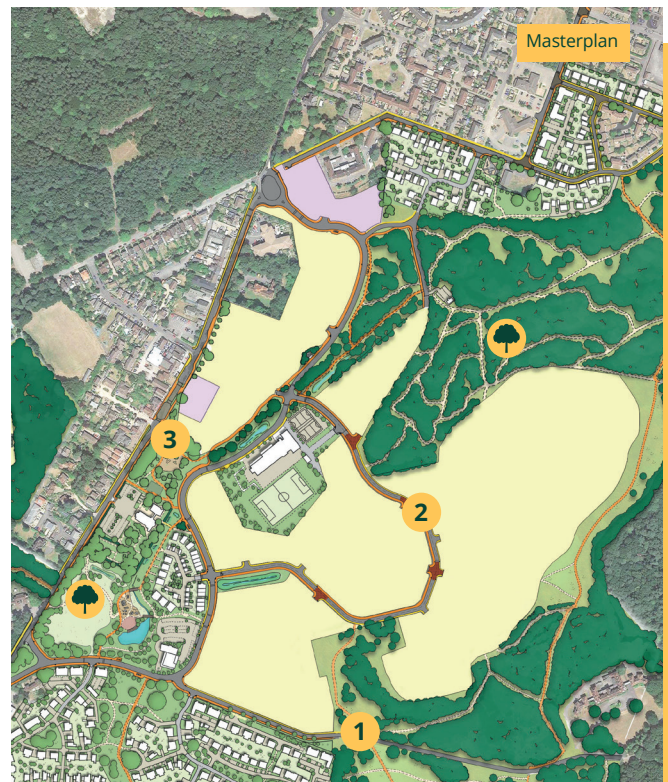

Construction Update

- 1** We will continue the demolition works to make way for the Southern SANGs; this includes crushing activities in the Fuel Depot area. There may be additional noise in this area for the next few weeks - we will continue to monitor noise during these works and, if needed, we will use sound barriers to manage noise levels.
 - 2** We will be progressing the Loop Road construction by installing foul and surface water drainage and other utilities.
 - 3** St. Barbara's external refurbishment works are ongoing, timber will be repainted, doors restored, and roofing and cladding will be receiving a final coat of paint. We anticipate that the scaffolding on the church will start to come down in April. We will also restore and install the spire once the scaffolding has been removed.
-  Landscape maintenance works will be continuing across the Village Green, Central SANGs and Mindenhurst Road.
 -  Bat barns and bat towers will be installed in the Blackdown ANGST and within the camp to support local bat populations across the site.



Update to Blu-3 electrical works

Deepcut Bridge Road (DBR) – After a slower than expected start due to the number of services crossing the route down at the BT exchange, the works are progressing swiftly along DBR heading northeast towards Newfoundland Road. The anticipated completion date is 03/03/2023. Once complete the site will be moving onto Lake Road where it will head west for nine weeks.

Hamesmoor Road – Works have picked up in the last month and the work is now progressing as planned. An unexpected concrete layer in the carriageway previously slowed progress. Our expected completion for Hamesmoor Road is now 17/03/2023.
